On page three there is a key which tells you which course is which, but can you match the numbers on the key to the points shown on the map?

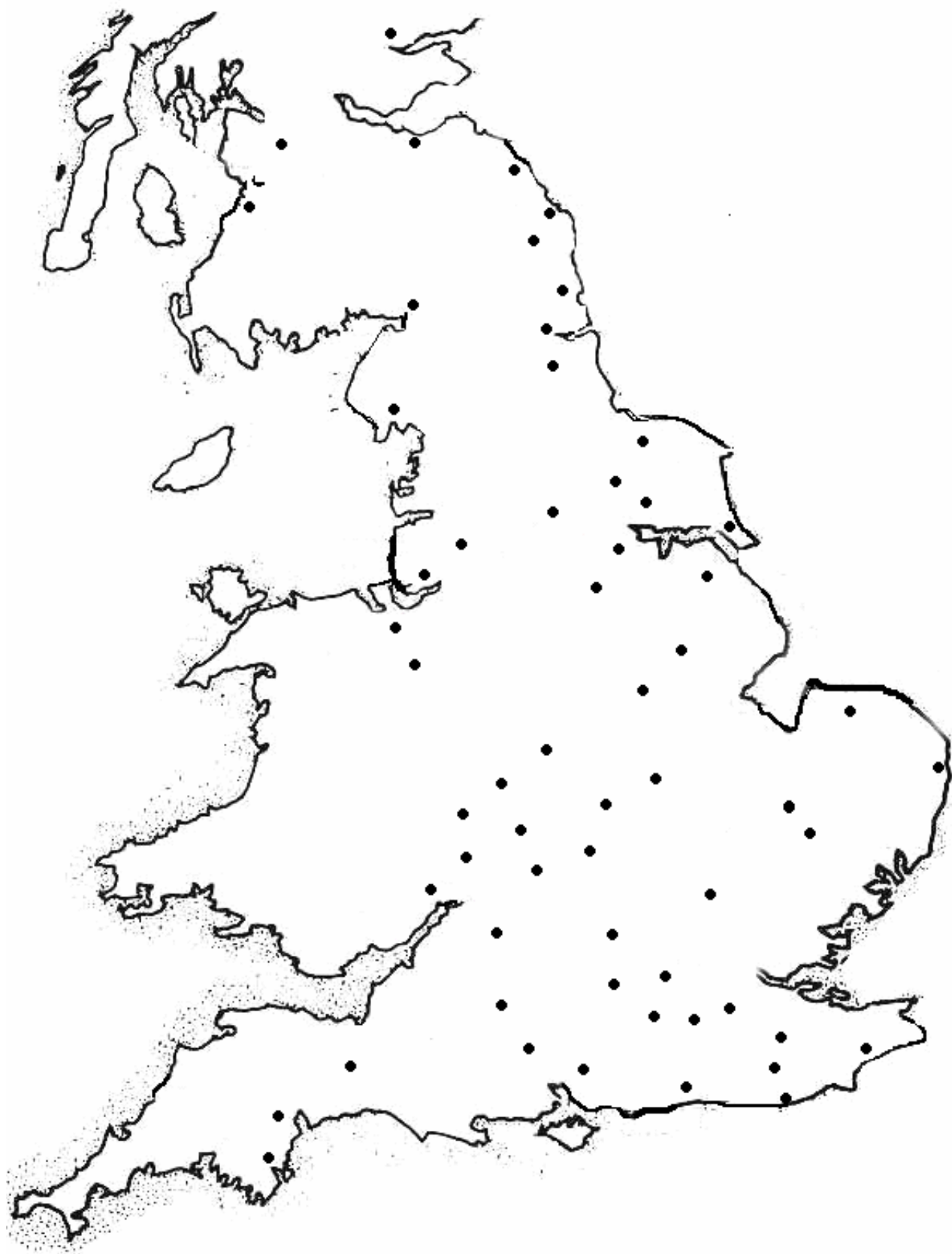
Go through each race in your race card and look at the map to see where the horses have come from. If you are not sure where a place is then ask someone for help.
